OVERVIEW

Personal Responsibility

- Renters and staff should self check temperatures and symptoms daily
- Sick individuals must stay home
- Don't show up if someone in your family is sick
- Wash hands and keep your social distance
- Gloves and Mask. If a renter lacks these items, Shelter will provide them

STUDIO RENTAL

Social Distancing

- Shelter will be partitioned into two separate shooting spaces (721 and 727), each with their own entrances, kitchens, and bathrooms
- Each space will be limited to 10 people in accordance with current CDC recommendations. (Shelter strongly encourages limiting the number of participants whenever possible)
- Adequate spacing of individuals including renters and Shelter Staff (6-10ft) at all times

Sanitization and Isolation

- Individual studio rental spaces will be sanitized and isolated 3 days prior to occupancy
- In cases where three days of isolation is not possible, Shelter will hire an authorized vendor to sanitize the studio. This cost is estimated to be \$300 and will be added to the invoice.
- Sanitizing stations will be located at the entrances, bathrooms, and kitchens of each space.

GEAR RENTAL

Sanitization and Isolation

• All gear will be sanitized and isolated for 3 days prior to use

Curbside Pick-up

- Staff and renters will be wearing gloves and mask during pick-up
- Shelter Staff will set gear outside of entrance of studio once renter has arrived, all required forms must be fill out and emailed
- Renter will be responsible for loading their own vehicles with the gear.

Curbside Returns

- Staff and renters should be wearing gloves and mask during drop-off
- Renters will notify staff that they arrive at Shelter's parking lot
- Renter will be responsible for unloading their own vehicles
- Shelter Staff will move gear into Shelter

Location Drop Off and Returns

- Staff will be wearing gloves and masks
- Gear will be dropped off outside, near an entrance or inside a dock entrance with a member of the crew
- Returns will be picked up at the drop off location, if possible.
